

## **MANAGER**

The manager must be something more than a coach. Knowledge of the game of Little League baseball is essential. While an adult with training and background in the game is a desirable candidate for manager, other qualities sometimes are more important. Managers must be sensitive to the mental and physical limitations of children. Further, they must recognize that the game is a vehicle of training and enjoyment, not an end in itself. Our program can only be as good as the quality of leadership that manager displays to his players and their parents. You will be required to attend a training course in first aid, a manager's clinic, and an umpire's clinic. Team responsibilities include organizing and managing practices (at least one per week), game (1-2 per week) and selecting and working with Assistant Coaches.

## **COACH**

This full season commitment requires assisting the Team Manager in the activities described above. A coach should possess all the qualities of a good manager. You will attend the same training courses as the manager. Lots of Fun!

## **TEAM PARENT**

This role is suited for anyone with strong organizational and communication skills. The Team Parent will be responsible for working with the manager and passing along information to the players and their families. Each team must have at least one Team Mom (or Dad). Activities may include: Making a team roster with the correct contact information, distributing uniforms and pictures, scheduling concession duties and snacks, organizing a team party, administer first aid, Etc. You will be required to attend a Team Parent Clinic before the start of the season.

### **Equipment Team**

We need two volunteers to assist our equipment officer in the distribution of equipment at the beginning of the season and the collection and inventorying at the end of the season.

### **Opening Day Team**

We need fifteen volunteers to assist in coordinating our Opening Day Ceremonies.

### **Evaluations Day Team**

This team will assist the Evaluating Team & Managers in making sure kids are in the right place at the right time. We need five persons each night of evaluations. (25 total).

### **Fields Team**

This team will assist with preparation of the fields between games during season play to ensure safe and playable conditions. We will need two volunteers per team.

**Concessions Officer**

This position ensures every game is covered with volunteers to assist in the opening, sales, restocking, cleanup and closing of our concession stand. This individual also coordinates the ordering, delivery and stocking of inventory. This individual will work hand in hand with our Treasurer to ensure deposits are made in a timely manner.

**Concessions Workers**

Each team is required to supply five volunteers for concessions duty. It is a three to four hour commitment for an assigned shift. Shifts are not assigned during your team's game. You will not miss any of the action.

Duties will include arriving a half hour before game time to set-up the concession stand and food prep, serving customers, collecting money, restocking items when necessary and staying afterwards to clean up.

This is a great way to contribute to the league in a "quick and easy" one time shift.

**Scorekeeper**

You will be keeping score for your team throughout the season. You will be required to attend a scorekeeping clinic before the season begins.
